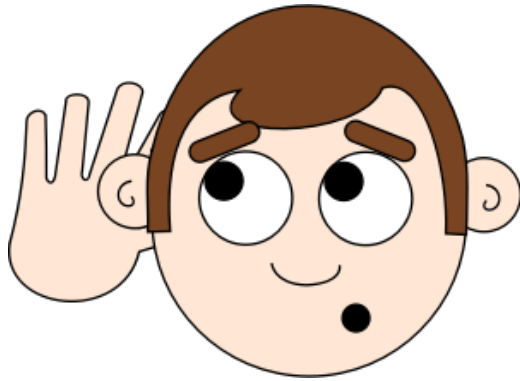

Our Senses
